Many young, beautiful Euro-Asian and Caucasian **girls** and **boys** are available for adoption **NOW**. EAC is currently accepting applications for families up to the age of 48!

Many girls, as well as boys, are available. Siblings and twins from the same region can be adopted at the same time. Infants (8 to 24 mos.), toddlers (2 to 5 yrs.) and older children are available.

Most Caucasians living in Kazakhstan are descendants of the Russians who relocated to Kazakhstan while it was still part of the Soviet Union. The largest population of children in Kazakhstan are Euro-Asian.

Additional family members are able to travel with you; however, lodging expenses/travel will increase depending upon the number of additional people.

Kazakhstan orphanages may be sparse, but the workers are kind and loving. The program is relatively uncomplicated and the Kazakhstan people are friendly.

The Kazakhstan staff plans many interesting trips, shopping, etc. to make the time in your child's homeland pleasant and memorable.



## Kazakhstan Requirements

- ★ Applications are accepted from married couples and single women.
- ★ Adoptive parents must be between the ages of 18 and 48
- ★ A single woman must be at least 25 yrs. older than the child she intends to adopt.
- ★ Both parents must hold a valid US passport
- ★ Applicants cannot have been divorced more than twice

## Travel

- ★ Our English-speaking coordinator is with you at all times during your adoption.
- ★ Travel is completed in 2-3 trips.
- ★ The first trip is approximately 3 weeks for visitation and bonding with your new baby.
- ★ After your first trip, you will return home for approximately 30 days
- ★ The second trip is approximately 7-14 days
- ★ Travel requirements may vary from region to region

## The Process and Procedures

- 1) Complete and submit the application for adoption.
- 2) You will work with your personal EAC adoption consultant to obtain contact information for a home study agency in the your state of residence.
- 3) File the I-600A immigration documents, specifying a Kazakhstan adoption, with cable sent to the U.S. Embassy in Almaty, Kazakhstan in accordance with state requirements.
- 4) Your EAC adoption consultant will assist you in completing the dossier documents.
- 5) Submit your completed dossier to EAC. EAC will review the dossier and submit it for authentication and Kazak translation. Next, the dossier will be submitted to the Embassy of Kazakhstan and the foreign government for authentication.
- 6) Parents will travel to Kazakhstan approximately two to five months upon submission of the dossier in Kazakhstan

	Visa fee at American Embassy in Almaty: \$400 per child + \$670 if adopting a second unrelated child (Example: 400 x 2 = 800 + 570 = \$1,470)
<b>Airfare Costs, Foreign Country Costs and In-Country Fees</b>	
	Airfare from America to Kazakhstan: \$1,200 to \$2,000 per person, per trip
	Foreign program fees: One child (8 months to 5 years): \$21,000-\$24,500; lodging, food and transportation in Kazakhstan ( approx. \$175-\$200 / day).
	Child's passport: \$1,000 per child/ consulate registration \$350 (includes transportation)
	Gifts (clothes, medicine, toys, and other supplies as needed by the orphanage): \$1,000 per child you are adopting
	Spending money (food, sight-seeing, shopping, etc.): \$1,500 - \$2,500
<b>Fees are subject to change and some fees may be non refundable. All applicants living abroad are assessed an additional service fee.</b>

## Travel to Kazakhstan

- Traveling to Kazakhstan is the easiest part of the adoption process. With EAC, all parents have to do is show up!
- EAC assists in all travel arrangements from airline tickets to hotel reservations.
- Upon arriving in Kazakhstan, families are greeted by an English speaking EAC representative.
- Your EAC representative will act as your guide in sightseeing and shopping so your families can experience the culture of Kazakhstan.
- Adopting families travel to their child's orphanage each day to initiate the bonding experience.
- Both parents must remain in country until the court hearing is complete. Additional trip may be completed by one parent, as long as the traveling parent has valid power of attorney from the other. An additional trip may be required.
- Time spent in region includes: required two weeks of visitation of child and court appointment; fifteen (15) day waiting period prior to adoption decree; paperwork filed and translated, obtaining child passport, medical appointment and U.S. Embassy appointment.
