Requirements for Letter of Guardianship

Guardian should be no older than 50 and no single men

(Only necessary for single women!)

It is preferred that the Guardian be in the same age or younger than the adoptive parent and a family member of the adoptive parent. Please no Grandparents.

- Address letter "To Whom It May Concern:"
- Full names of guardians (must be married couple)
- Ages
- Professions
- Number and age(s) of children if applicable
- Length of marriage
- Living conditions in the home (how many stories, number of bedrooms, nice yard, nice family neighborhood, etc.)
- Guardians relationship to adoptive parent
- Length of relationship to adoptive parent
- Guardians must state they accept the role of guardianship for the adopted child(ren)
- Guardians must state they are very supportive and excited about the adoption
- Guardians must state they intend to be an active part in the life of your child(ren)
